

- ✓ 31 Majors are offered under the College of Liberal Arts and all students belong to this college.
- \checkmark Students are not required to select the major when they enter ICU.
- ✓ At the end of sophomore year, after taking courses from various fields, students decide their major.
- Completion of the Japanese Language Programs (JLP) is a part of ICU graduation requirement. The duration of the JLP varies according to the students' Japanese proficiency at the time of enrollment.


Educational Support

Advisor System

A professor is assigned to each student to advise his/her course of study. Students may consult their advisors about various matters.

Academic Planning Center

The Academic Planning Center is to support students as they make their choices in planning their curricula. The center and advisors work together in a joint effort to support student life at ICU.



Bilingual Education

2 languages used on campus

ICU is a bilingual university where courses across the curriculum are taught in both English and Japanese.

About $\frac{1}{4}$ of the classes are taught in **English** and rest are offered in **Japanese**.

Students take courses taught in Japanese after they have completed the Japanese Language Programs and they are equipped with a high degree of Japanese proficiency when they graduate.






Japanese Language Programs (JLP)

- ICU offers one of the world's best Japanese language programs from the introductory level to the very advanced level.
- Students are not required to have any prior Japanese knowledge before the enrollment.
- According to the result of the placement test, students are placed to the appropriate level courses
- Completion of JLP is part of the graduation requirements for degree-seeking students who are not fluent in Japanese.
- ◆By the time of graduation, students will become functionally bilingual.








Westfälische wilhelm-universität münster & International Christian University

Westfälische Wilhelm-Universität Münster (WWU) and International Christian University (ICU) signed the exchange agreement in 1991.

Currently, ICU has 63 exchange partners in 21 countries, and WWU is the 24th partner university and 5th among universities in Europe.

Student Exchange: constantly sending students to each university for 20 years (20 students from WWU to ICU, 23 students from ICU to WWU)

Joint Conference: In September 2006, WWU-ICU Joint Conference, "Cultural Diversity and Social Integration," was held on ICU campus.
