Quick guide to using lecture hall microphones and a built-in camera for a video conference with Zoom:

--- Instructions for a Windows laptop ---

- **Step 1:** Start the media system via the touch panel in the console.
- **Step 2:** Turn on the projector as usual and connect your laptop with HDMI or VGA + 3.5mm audio jack. Select the appropriate connection on the touch panel.
- **Step 3**: Connect the USB cable labeled "Conference Sound" to your laptop.
- **Step 4:** Windows drivers will now be installed automatically.
- **Step 5:** Once setup is complete, here's how to integrate the audio from your lecture hall microphones into Zoom.

Select under Settings->Audio->Microphone->

"Microfon (Scarlett 2i2 USB)"



Additionally when using HDMI: Under Settings->Audio->Speakers->




Alternatively, the same settings can be selected via the microphone symbol in a Zoom session that has already started:
