Departmental Colloquium (in module 1 and module 4)

Students are expected to submit **three response papers** on sessions of invited speakers at the Departmental Colloquium: **two in Module 1, and one in Module 4**. Submissions to other modules are not eligible and non-negotiable. Please attend to the following minimal instructions for your guidance.

Module 1

Students prepare **two** response papers (logs) about a session of their choice. Each response paper comprises of the following components:

Format: 2 pages, 1 ½ line spacing, 12p font, continuous text

Content: a) 1-page summary; b) ½ page presentation/documentation of the discussion/Q&A; c) ½ page of (constructive) critical and personal engagement (reflection) with the presentation/talk; d) a short list of five references from anthropological journals on the topic of the presentation/talk

Module 4

Students prepare **one** response paper (log) about a session of their choice. The response paper comprises of the following components:

Format: 2 pages, 1 ½ line spacing, 12p font, continuous text

Content: a) 1-page summary; b) ½ page presentation/documentation of the discussion/Q&A; c) ½ page of (constructive) critical and personal engagement (reflection) with the presentation/talk; d) a short list of five references from anthropological journals on the topic of the presentation/talk
