This course is the result of many years of cooperation between the Faculty of Catholic Theology of the University of Münster and the St. Victor and St. Augustine Major Seminary Tamale, Ghana.

The aim is to provide a deeper understanding of the meaning of catholicity in a global Catholic Church and to shed light on the challenges and opportunities that arise from the diversity of ecclesial cultures and contextual ecclesiologies. Special attention will be given to the question of how catholicity can contribute to the promotion of an intercultural theology that respects the diversity of regional ecclesial landscapes and enables dialogue between different cultural and theological traditions.

Presentations by invited guests from the global church will help to bring in a wide range of perspectives and experiences and to elevate the academic discourse to a higher level. The course will be held in English only.
