



Checklist for the Admission to the Examination Phase

Personal details of the doctoral candidate with address
written thesis (dissertation) in four copies (typewritten, bound and paginated) as well as an electronic version of the thesis on a common data carrier with the text of the thesis saved in a common data format
if applicable, proof of the required coursework and examinations in accordance with § 3 para. 5 to 8 (Supplementary Study Programme)
the proof of completion of the doctoral programme required in § 6 (2) to (3) (Course Record Book)
written curriculum vitae in tabular form with a description of the academic career
the decision on the chosen form of the oral examination procedure (§11)
a recommendation issued by the responsible ecclesiastical Ordinarius for the application for the doctoral degree
Declaration of plagiarism (§8)
A foreign-language dissertation must be accompanied by a table of contents in German and a summary (five to ten pages) in German. (§7)
