



Checklist for the Admission to the Examination Phase

- Personal details of the doctoral candidate with address
- written thesis (dissertation) in four copies (typewritten, bound and paginated) as well as an electronic version of the thesis on a common data carrier with the text of the thesis saved in a common data format
- if applicable, proof of the required coursework and examinations in accordance with § 3 para. 5 to 8 (Supplementary Study Programme)
- the proof of completion of the doctoral programme required in § 6 (2) to (3) (Course Record Book)
- written curriculum vitae in tabular form with a description of the academic career
- the decision on the chosen form of the oral examination procedure (§11)
- a recommendation issued by the responsible ecclesiastical Ordinarius for the application for the doctoral degree
- Declaration of plagiarism (§8)
- A foreign-language dissertation must be accompanied by a table of contents in German and a summary (five to ten pages) in German. (§7)
